

Copyright Policy

Roboplan Technologies Ltd. aka LetItMake ("LetItMake") respects the copyrights of others and expects its users to do the same. It is LetItMake's policy, in appropriate circumstances and at its discretion, to disable or terminate the accounts of users who repeatedly infringe or are repeatedly charged with infringing the copyrights or other intellectual property rights of others.

1. Copyright Infringement Notification

If you believe in good faith your copyright-protected work was posted on our site without authorization, you may submit a copyright infringement notification. These requests should only be submitted by the copyright owner or an agent authorized to act on the owner's behalf.

The fastest and simplest way to notify LetItMake of alleged copyright infringement is by submitting a notice of copyright infringement ("**Notice**") via support@letitmake.com. We will also accept copyright infringement notifications, submitted by mail to the following address Roboplan Technologies Ltd. at Alfasi 5, Tel Aviv, Israel

If you choose to request removal of content by submitting an infringement Notice, please remember that you are initiating a legal process.

Note: Do not make false claims. Misuse of this process may result in the suspension of your account or other legal consequences.

Please provide the following information in your Notice:

1. Identify the copyrighted work that you claim has been infringed, or - if multiple copyrighted works are covered by this Notice - you may provide a representative list of the copyrighted works that you claim have been infringed.
2. Identify (i) the material that you claim is infringing (or to be the subject of infringing activity) and that is to be removed or access to which is to be disabled, and information reasonably sufficient to permit us to locate the material, including at a minimum, if applicable, the URL of the link shown on the Site where such material may be found, and (ii) the reference or link, to the material or activity that you claim to be infringing, that is to be removed or access to which is to be disabled, and information reasonably sufficient to permit us to locate that reference or link, including at a minimum, if applicable, the URL of the link shown on the Site where such reference or link may be found.
3. Provide your mailing address, telephone number, and, if available, email address.
4. Include both of the following statements in the body of the Notice:

"I hereby state that I have a good faith belief that the disputed use of the copyrighted material or reference or link to such material is not authorized by the copyright owner, its agent, or the law (e.g., as a fair use)."

"I hereby state that the information in this Notice is accurate and, under penalty of perjury, that I am the owner, or authorized to act on behalf of the owner, of the copyright or of an exclusive right under the copyright that is allegedly infringed."

5. Provide your full legal name and your electronic or physical signature.

6. Deliver this Notice, with all items completed, to the email or mail address listed above.

2. What if I receive a Copyright Complaint notification?

If you receive a notification that your Content, Project Design, or Contribution (as such terms are defined in the Terms of Service) has been removed due a copyright complaint, it means that it has been deleted from the site at the request of the content's owner. If you want us to forward the information from the Notice, just reply to the notification to let us know. We'll be happy to send it along (without any personal contact information). If your account receives too many copyright complaints, you may lose the ability to submit Content, Project Design, and Contribution, and your account may be disabled completely.

If you believe it was removed in error, you have the option to file a counter-notice by following the steps below. When LetItMake receive a valid counter-notice, LetItMake will forward a copy to the person who filed the original complaint Notice. If we do not receive notice within 10 business days that the submitter of the original complaint is seeking a court order to prevent further infringement of the content at issue, LetItMake will remove the complaint from your account's record, and we may replace the content that was removed.

Note: There are legal and financial consequences for fraudulent and/or bad faith submissions. Before submitting a counter-notice, be sure that you are the actual rights holder of the removed content or that you have a good faith belief that the material was removed in error, and understand the repercussions of submitting a false claim.

3. How to File a Counter-Notice

1. Email your counter-notice to support@letitmake.com
2. Include ALL of the following:
 - o Your name, address, and telephone number.
 - o Complaint ID printed at the bottom of the notification email.
 - o The source address of the content that was removed (copy and paste the link in the notification email).
 - o A statement under penalty of perjury that you have a good faith belief that the content was removed in error.
 - o A statement that you consent to the jurisdiction of courts in which the source address is located, or if your address is outside of Israel, for any judicial district in which LetItMake may be found, and that you will accept service of process from the person who provided the original complaint Notice or an agent of such person.
 - o A physical or electronic signature (for example, typing your full name).

4. Claims regarding Content and Project Design other than copyright infringement

For issues other than copyright infringement, such as inappropriate content, spam, safety concerns, trademark issues or false profile, please review our Terms of Service and contact support@letitmake.com.
